Ashland Athletic Hall of Fame Selection Committee Member Criteria

SELECTION COMMITTEE STRUCTURE

1. MEMBER CRITERIA

- Committee members must be Ashland High School Alumni or have been involved in Ashland Athletics, past or present, as a coach or administrator for a minimum of five years
 - Candidates which meet both of these criteria are highly requested
- The committee will be composed of members that represent different eras of involvement in Ashland High School Athletics
 - ➤ Candidates which have been involved with Ashland High School Athletics for 8 or more years are highly requested
- The committee will be composed of members that were involved in different sports at Ashland High School
 - Candidates which have been involved in multiple sports programs are highly requested
- The committee will be composed of members that were involved in boys' programs and members that were involved in girls' programs
 - Candidates which have been involved in both boys' and girls' programs are highly requested

2. COMMITTEE SIZE AND SELECTION

- The committee must consist of exactly 14 members
- The committee will be selected through collaboration with current committee members and current coaches at Ashland High School
- Committee members will be asked to serve for a three year term with opportunity to be nominated for an additional two terms

3. COMMITTEE DUTIES / EXPECTATIONS

- The committee will meet 3 times annually, once in the Fall and twice in the Spring
- The committee is responsible for extensively reviewing the nominations and requesting more information from the nominees when necessary
- The committee will make selections for Hall of Fame inductees on an annual basis
- The committee is responsible for assisting in planning and staging the annual inductee ceremony/banquet
- The committee will have the ability to change selection criteria only for the following year's selections
